IV. Long Term Strategy – Marty Fallon

Fr. Wittman hired Teamworks International, an outside consulting firm, to create a long range plan for this Parish. Fr. Wittman chose to not have the PPC involved. In the fall of 2009, the PPC heard a presentation by school Principal Jane Nordin. She shared the school was renewing their accreditation and reviewing goals. She challenged the PPC to create a long term plan.

Rick K. - The PPC does not have a portfolio outlining our responsibilities. Most members come here believing half of our agenda is to develop and plan long term. Frame work needs to be developed. The government is having a nationwide census perhaps we can have a 2010 parish wide Census and a review of PPC Constitution.

Discussion then centered on two questions;
